

What to Expect?

The Juneteenth Community Celebration & Unity Walk 2022 is a community event to commemorate and celebrate Juneteenth. As you enter Thurman Springs Park, there will be a HIStory Tent, HIStory, Prayer, Manga African Dance Group (Sponsored by Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Incorporated Rho Epsilon Zeta Chapter), Storytelling with youth performances (Sponsored by Rich Mom), Unity Choir, Unity Message, Dove Release (Sponsored by Heritage Funeral Home) and we symbolically walk ½ back to the Motherland and return to the music of The Wildmann & Funky Soul Band. Infused with Food Vendors and non-food vendors as the family gathers to celebrate Juneteenth and celebrate the fathers on their day, Father's Day!

There will be a Father's Day Grill Raffle. Get your tickets early!

What time should I arrive?

The celebration starts at 3pm with the Welcome by Mayor A L. Thurman. Allow time to find parking and get the best seating possible. You decide to sit close to the food or close to the music! Get there early and enjoy this community celebration from 3pm-8pm

What is the cost?

Admission to this event is **FREE** and open to the public. We will have vendors selling their merchandise and food vendors.

Will there be alcohol?

No alcohol. Our event takes place in the Entertainment District, and Alcohol is NOT allowed inside of the Entertainment District. Thank you.

Can I bring a cooler?

We will have food trucks and vendors. We encourage you to support our vendors. Please bring water to remain hydrated.

Can I set up a tent and tables?

No tents or tables may be set up inside of the event location as they can interfere with the view of other guests. Please be considerate of other attendees.

Important info to know before you come:

- The City of Powder Springs nor Unity In HIStory Outreach Foundation, Inc., is responsible for any items left unattended throughout the day.
- No tobacco use of any kind is permitted in the park.
- Seating is on a first come, first serve basis.
- Only blankets and lawn chairs are allowed for seating inside of the park. NO chairs of any kind are allowed on the synthetic turf in the play area.
- Rope, tape, stakes, etc. used to section off areas inside the park will be removed.
